



Detective Assigned to the Case: Detective Jim Michaels

Case Description

On June 5, 2017, at approximately 9:45 a.m. a call was received from Taylor Daniels who resides at 111 Salmon Lane. She reported seeing smoke at a neighboring fishing cabin located at 123 Trout Lane, just on the outskirts of the city of Bass Lake. The BLPD, as well as the fire department, were dispatched to 123 Trout Lane.

City of Bass Lake property records show the fishing cabin is owned by Matthew Hartmann.

Preliminary Observations

When the police and firefighters arrived, the firemen immediately located the smoke as coming from a burning shed at the back of the property. They quickly extinguished the fire. Once the fire had been put out, the police canvassed the scene. The following areas were searched and observations documented.

The Fishing Cabin

- 1. One window in the back of the cabin had been broken. Glass from the window was found on the inside of one of the two bedrooms in the cabin.
- 2. Upon further inspection of bedroom #1, 15 stacks of twenty-dollar bills totaling \$15,000 were found in the closet.
- 3. Also recovered from bedroom #1 was a high resolution printer.
- 4. Police officers discovered a gun under the front porch.
- 5. An iPhone was found on the kitchen table.
- 6. A handwritten list was also found on the kitchen table.

Lake Iwannafisha

- 1. A small lake lies in the front of the property.
- 2. A rowboat was pulled up on the bank of the lake in front of the fishing cabin.

The Shed

- 1. A wooden shed exists on the back of the property approximately 500 yards from the cabin. The shed, on fire when authorities arrived, was partially damaged by the fire before the fire was extinguished.
- 2. An empty gasoline can was found at the back of the shed.
- 3. An unidentified body was found dead in the shed.
- 4. Two bullets were found embedded in the west side wall of the shed.

Pick-Up Truck

- 1. On the east side of the shed, a blue Ford pick-up truck was found. The truck had no license plates. The VIN was located and was documented as C4PWR7JLW99623.
- 2. Keys were found in the ignition of the truck.
- 3. A gun was found in the glove box.

Shallow Grave

- 1. In the woods behind the cabin, just west of the shed, a shallow grave was discovered.
- 2. Four bones were found at the grave.

This concludes the preliminary crime scene report. Evidence will be collected and analyzed by the appropriate departments.
