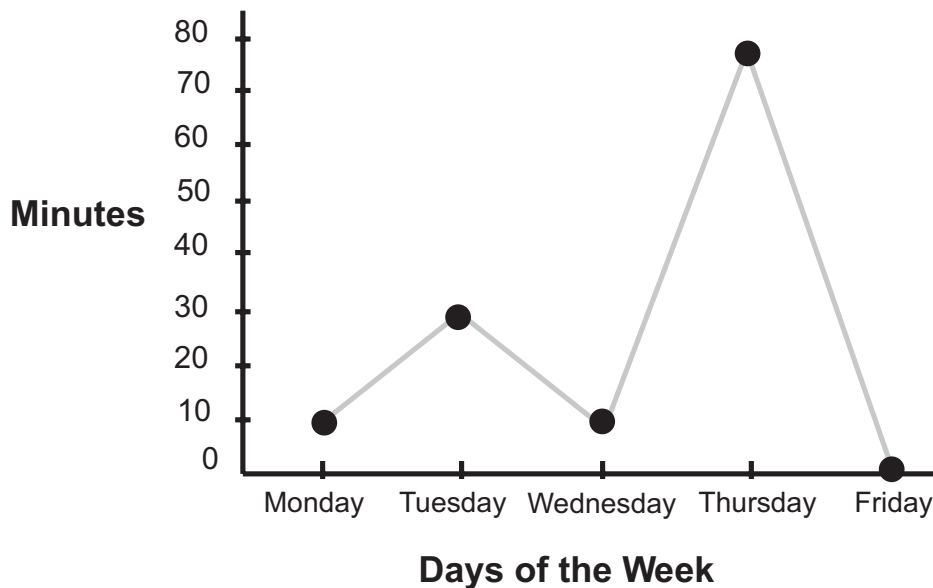


### 35—Time for Homework
