"8I must have been the second person to choose a candy bar since there were only two left when I picked my candy bar. ${ }^{9}$ I don't know what time it was because Ike and I don't have watches."

## Ike:

"10Sometime just after 7:30 p.m. I went to pick a candy bar, but there weren't any candy bars left on the table. ${ }^{11}$ I know it was just after 7:30 since the TV program we were watching is on from $7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. to 7:30 p.m. ${ }^{12} \mathrm{I}$ saw Bret and Tonya eating candy bars during the show."

## Mom:

${ }^{113}$ I put three small candy bars on a plate and then placed the plate on the kitchen table a little before $7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. ${ }^{14} \mathrm{I}$ don't wear a watch, but we always eat dinner around 6:30 p.m. and it takes us about 20 minutes."

## Dad:

${ }^{\text {"15 }}$ I saw three candy bars on the plate when I left for the gym at 7:20 p.m. ${ }^{16} \mathrm{I}$ didn't take a candy bar."
